We are glad to see summer here and everything opening up for business. We have all safety measures in place at our Thrift Shops, Food Pantry, and Family Assistance Office.

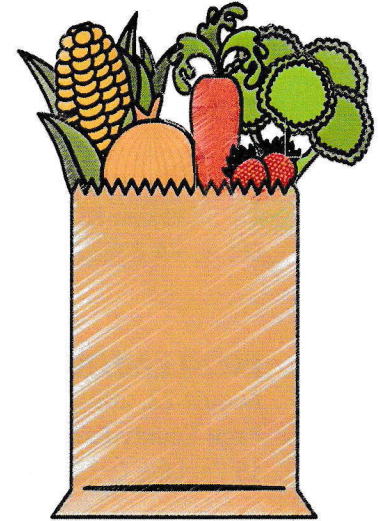

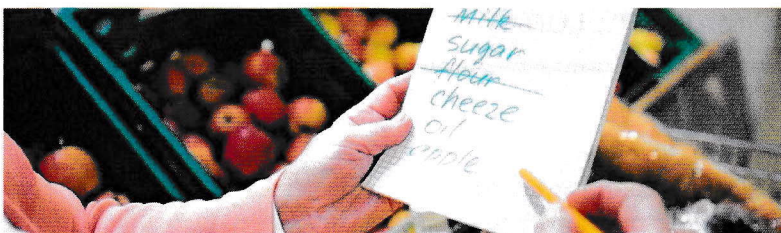
WHO DO WE HELP?
