the food impoverished in Page County can stock their shelves at home. We see an average of 196 individuals each month which represents an average of 72 households. The men and women who work in the food pantry are a dedicated, hardworking bunch that show up week in and week out to make sure that food is received, stored, and distributed safely and properly. In all, they have an average of 14 volunteers who work almost 400 hours each month to help our local clients!
